



The purpose of Block Districts and Block District Captains is to help connect and organize neighbors, in order to create a more livable and resilient neighborhood.

Block District - a geographical region within a neighborhood, consisting of one or more blocks that are closely aligned.

Block District Captain - resident of a Block District that takes primary responsibility for the communication, shared resources, and neighborhood events within the district's boundaries.

BDC Assistant - resident within a Block District that specializes in either communicating with neighbors, resource sharing, or organizing neighborhood events.

What are the Block District Captain's/Co-Captain's responsibilities?
Ensure that neighbors within your Block District are informed about neighborhood activities, issues, resources, and projects. The Block Captains may delegate responsibilities to BDC Assistants. The rest is up to you.

Community sharing is happening all across the neighborhood.
