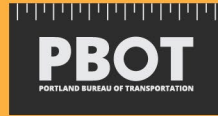

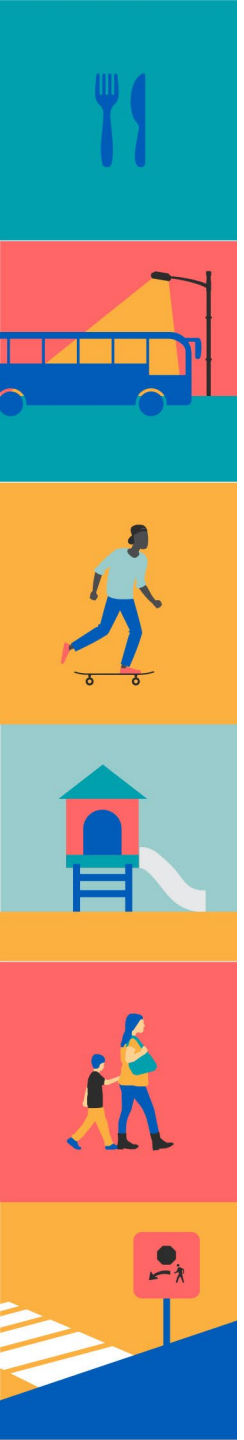

# Building a Better 82nd Avenue

## Critical Fixes 2023 - 2026

---



**STRIPING, SIGNING, TRAFFIC SIGNAL TECHNOLOGY – COMPLETE**



**SIGNALIZED PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS – UNDER CONSTRUCTION**

New or upgraded signalized pedestrian crossings with median islands and tree planting.



**STREET LIGHTING – STARTING SOON**

54 new street lights will be added and 245 existing street lights will be improved across the corridor to improve visibility.



**PAVEMENT & CURB RAMPS – 2024-2026**

2.5 miles of 82nd Avenue will be repaved in 2025 and 2026. Additional improvements along these repaved segments include improved curb ramps, crossing and signal improvements, transit improvements, median islands in some locations, and tree planting.



**TRAFFIC SIGNALS – 2024-2026**

Traffic signals will be rebuilt along 82nd Avenue to include modern safety and traffic operation technology.

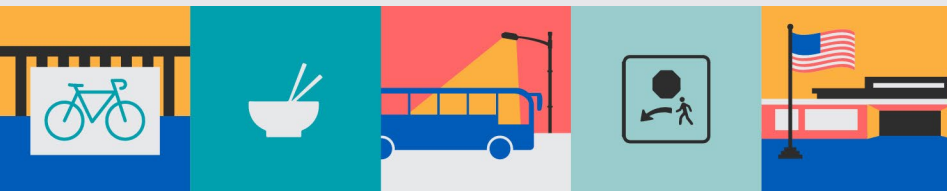

## Future Investments 2026 and Beyond

---



### **ADDITIONAL SAFETY & MAINTENANCE PROJECTS**

PBOT staff and the 82nd Ave Community Advisory Committee are developing a list of additional safety and maintenance projects for 82nd Avenue informed by data analysis, City policy guidance, and public engagement.



### **EQUITABLE DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY FOR COMMUNITY STABILIZATION**

Identifies a range of strategies to support existing businesses and residents along 82nd Avenue.



### **FUTURE TRANSIT PLANNING**

PBOT is working closely with Metro, TriMet, and community-based organizations to decide on future investments that support transit along 82nd Avenue.
