Following our practice of meeting with candidates who request time with our Association, we hosted Mary Lou Heinrich who is running in the May Democratic Primary for State Representative in Portland's HD 46. Her brief overview was followed by a lively Q&A with community members.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Treasurer: Since we hadn't met in December (holiday) or January (weather), Brian gave an overview of STNA's successful co-hosted Thanksgiving event at Findley Commons. This included food and a drive for Christmas gifts. STNA's current budget is approximately \$5800.

Land Use: John summarized the Portland Neighbors Welcome campaign "Inner East Side for All" to bring greater density & affordable housing that would up-zone western parts of South Tabor (currently up to SE 60th, but could change); reported that SE Powell crossings continue to be in the midst of bureaucratic approvals; 82nd Ave improvements should begin this summer; bus line #71 will gain frequent service

Communications (Taran) discussion of beefing up the website by adding photos and mini-profiles of board members. Cathy and Taran offered an overview of a quarterly Newsletter, which generated enthusiasm from board and community members.

No votes were taken by the board.
