### **Committee Updates:**

Treasurer: \$5400 as of 5/31/2024; up-to-date with tax filing

Land Use: -No meeting this month, here are some updates; TriMet nearing 90% design on pedestrian crossings, but things are moving forward, including upgrade to currently temporary crossing at 64th & Division; tax increment financing (TIF) district for 82nd Ave is in planning stages (a way to raise tax money & keep it local for infrastructure improvement); SEUL LUTC will recommend that the SEUL board endorse the Inner Eastside for All campaign (reps came to Land Use meeting in 2023); in July there will be a public forum for the community to give feedback on the Burnside Bridge rebuild; demolition and development of the former LDS Church site at SE Tibbetts & 73rd appear to be moving ahead, but because the property is not a 1-4 dwelling residence (it's deemed commercial), there is no requirement to notify neighbors or STNA.

Events: Juan reported on June 8 Yard Sale and Garden Tour. 60 sales, 10 garden tours; \$515 earned; next year's (like this year's) will take place last Saturday before kids get out of PPS for the summer.

Communications: direct mail physical postcard has led to 300 new signups for the mailing list, and the South Tabor Newsletter *Crow* has been well received.

SEUL: Matchu Williams gave an overview of supports offered to the community and updates related to the July 1 transition to new city government structure where there will be 19 rather than 20 neighborhoods in SE Uplift coalition. Visit [southeastuplift.org](http://southeastuplift.org) for details.
