• Update on the Powell Frontage Roads The city has taken action after the recent violence in the neighborhood. Learn more about that and what STNA is doing to help give community input.

Brian reported for Vigidis (chair of the Powell Frontage Road subcommittee):

Short term: city putting up barriers in three locations as a safety measure after recent shootings and concerns over encampments of houseless people;

- Long-term solutions under consideration are affordable housing, play spaces, and community gardens, but it's a process complicated by overlapping jurisdictions (PBOT and ODOT).

# UPCOMING EVENTS:

**Neighborhood yard sale/garden tour June 9**; looking for folks to get involved in setting it up, reaching out to local businesses to advertise on the brochure/map; will be working on this in April/May; some discussion of involving Kellogg marching band and school more generally by having it be a possible hub; discussion of how to publicize, whether door-to-door or sending out a USPS mailing.

## **GUEST SPEAKER**:

Spencer Goad, Kellogg Middle School. **Supporting Kellogg Middle School Music program.** Kellogg will be expanding their music program next year and is looking for community support to make it a fantastic program; Spencer teaches band and guitar; "it's incidental that I teach music" but rather it's about problem-solving and learning new skills, "another adult teaching your kid how not to be a jerk"; has to fundraiser \$8K a year to do special events; trying to get small businesses to devote to the program; most donation opps are through the school itself; liked the idea of getting the band to participate at the neighborhood association garage sale/garden day.

## POSSIBLE ACTION ITEMS BASED ON DISCUSSIONS:

- 1. Establish **collaboration between STNA & Foster-Powell Neighborhood Association** to plan for Powell improvements
- 2. Create a working group to discuss luring businesses to the neighborhood that people want rather than be passive about what businesses swoop in
- 3. Inspire greater collaboration between STNA and local businesses—what would this look like?
- 4. Create an **online map to show all the different little libraries** in front of houses and their specialties
- 5. Build community on blocks and the neighborhood to encourage safety
- 6. Project to encourage tree-planting: no updates
- 7. Planning for mural painting at 67th & Woodward and block party
